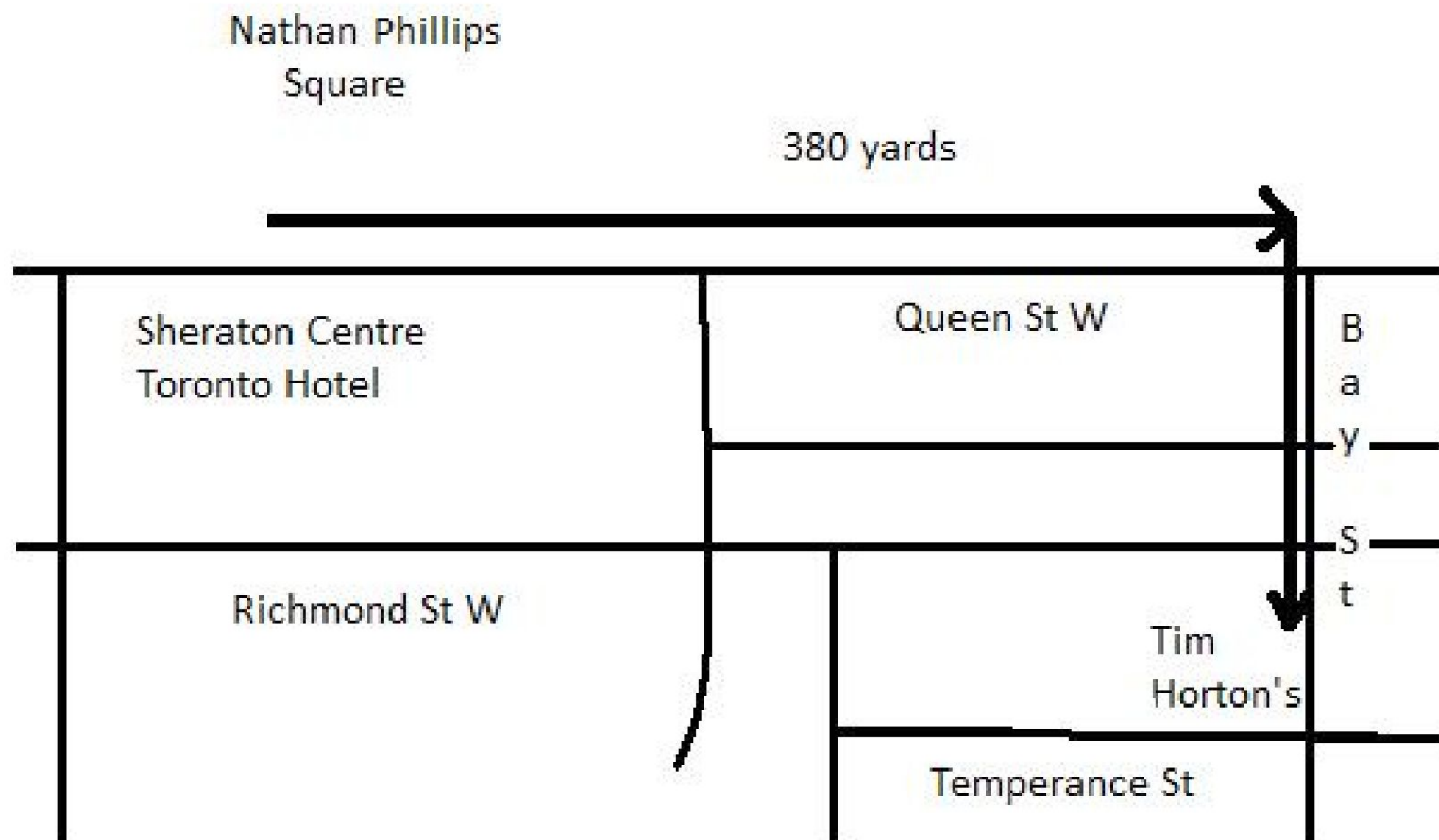


Lifeboat Foundation Speed-Networking Bull-Session Improvisational Urban Adventure

A serendipitous mixture of good conversation and empty seats in Tim Horton's might motivate some to stay there, but we anticipate that others will drink their coffee and go elsewhere. The first challenge is to decide where. This will depend on serendipitous match ups of groups of six or so, groups that are similar on factors such as whether you need to get back for the next topic on the conference agenda, the BetaLaunch; how much you want to spend for dinner; whether you would like to look at an interesting urban park across from the conference hotel; and a topic in which you are interested.

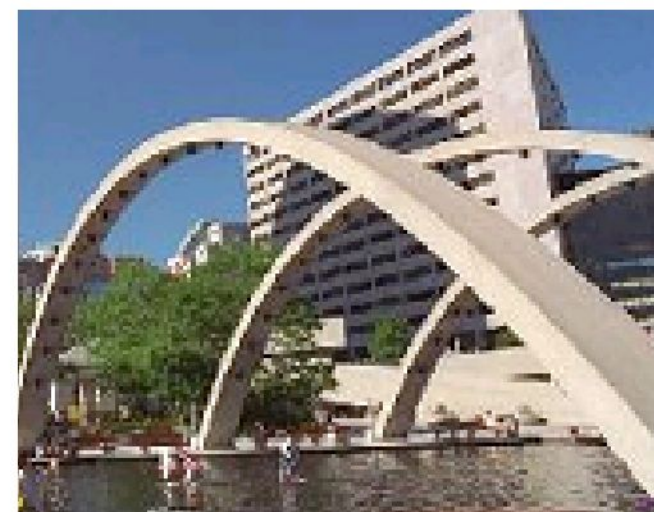
If you need to get back to the hotel for the BetaLaunch at 6:30, attach this icon:
